Trading Notes

Thank you all for your continued support. It is great to see you when you visit us at the Trading hut.

We have just received delivery of the spring flowering bulbs so come and have a look at what we have before they all get sold. Also available are onion sets. Amaryllis bulbs and garlic bulbs are expected in the next week or so.

We are now taking orders for seed potatoes (**price list attached**) that will be ready for collection in February next year. Please place your orders now to make sure that you get the varieties and the quantities you need. Some people missed out last year as they forgot to order. We expect delivery in late January or early February. We have good stocks of Rosedale compost both ordinary and Peat Free. Those who have been buying Peat Free mostly say that the quality has improved since we first started selling it.

Please remember we take both credit and debit cards and there is no minimum purchase necessary or charge for this service.

Don't forget, if there is something that you are looking for and we don't stock it, please let me know and I will try and obtain in for you. We have got several special items for customers recently, so just ask. We want to stock items that you want.

New, and old, members may like to be reminded the EMGS Trading Depot is on the Beauchamp Road Allotment Site (entrance between 104 and 106 Beauchamp Road, East Molesey, KT8 0PH).

We are open on Sundays from 9.00 am to 11.00 am until and including the 26th November 2023. We then close over Christmas and New Year, reopening on Sunday 4th February 2024. We will also be opening on Wednesday evenings from 7.00pm till 8.00pm during the months of April, May and June in 2024.

A reminder that parking is limited when the depot is open, so please only bring your vehicle on site if you are purchasing anything heavy. Also please remember that there is a site speed limit of 5 mph for obvious reasons.
